Subj: POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR INSTALLATION OF COMMAND, CONTROL, COMPUTERS, COMMUNICATIONS, INTELLIGENCE, SURVEILLANCE AND RECONNAISSANCE (C4ISR) SYSTEMS AT SHORE FACILITIES

1. Purpose. To establish policy and procedures to be used by Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR) and subordinate Commands when installing C4ISR systems at shore facilities.

2. Cancellation. SPAWAR Instruction 2804.1 of 15 August 1986, SPAWAR Instruction 5200.11A of 23 December 1987 and the requirements in SPAWAR NOTICE 5201 of 26 April 1999 are superseded by this instruction.

3. Background. Ensuring our fleet activities keep pace with the rapid development of emerging technologies requires that we implement a standardized installation process. The process should coordinate the efforts of the various Program Managers, provide integrated planning for each installation site and deliver consistently high quality results for installations of any size, scope and location. Reference (a) provides standard procedures and sample documents to be used during each of the six phases of the shore installation process: work plan development, planning, design, pre-installation tasks, installation and system turnover.

4. Policy. It is the policy of the Commander, Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command that the Installations and Logistics Directorate (SPAWAR 04) will be responsible for the successful installation and testing of SPAWAR systems and products. Reference (a) shall be used by SPAWAR activities as the governing document for installations at shore facilities. Reference (b) provides guidance on safety precautions and safe working practices to be used by installers of electronic systems at shore facilities.

5. Action. SPAWAR headquarters and its activities personnel shall use the guidance provided in reference (a). The Installations and Logistics Directorate (SPAWAR 04) shall maintain reference (a) and distribute current copies throughout the SPAWAR claimancy.
