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Space & Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO — Raytheon Company, Network Centric Systems, Marlborough, Mass., is being awarded a \$3,104,774 incrementally funded cost plus award fee, fixed price, time and material contract. This contract is for the design, development, integration, testing and production of the Navy Advanced Extremely High Frequency (AEHF) Multi-band Terminal (NMT). The NMT is a multi-band capable satellite communications terminal that will be installed on ship, shore, and submarine platforms. This contract includes options which, if exercised, would bring the cumulative value of this contract to \$1,657,442,430. This contract combines purchases for the U.S. Navy (94.76 %) and the government(s) of Canada (3.72%) and Netherlands (1.52%) under the Foreign Military Sales Program. Initial work will be performed in Marlborough, Mass., and is expected to have all deliveries completed by fiscal year 2014. Contract funds in the amount of \$3,104,774 will initially be funded with FY 2003 Research Development Test and Evaluation, Navy funds and will expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract is not a multiyear contract and was competitively procured on a full and open competitive basis with two offers received via the SPAWAR E-commerce web site and announced in FedBizOpps. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, San Diego, Calif., is the contracting activity (N00039-04-C-0012).
