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SPAWAR Systems Center San Diego Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO — Trex Enterprises Corp., of San Diego, is being awarded a \$5,699,938 cost-plus-fixed-fee, indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity type contract for maintenance and upgrading of the existing Rapid Optical Beam Steering (ROBS) System, operation of ROBS in the field in support of government missions, and development of new sensor technologies and related optical technology systems. This three-year contract includes two, one-year options, which, if exercised, would bring the potential cumulative value of this contract to \$9,806,590. Work will be performed in San Diego (80%); and Kauai, Hawaii (20%). The period of performance of the base contract is from September 14, 2004 through September 13, 2007. If all options are exercised, work will continue through September 2009. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This is a sole source contract award for original manufacturer-supplied equipment required on an urgent basis to support military operations.
