CHARLESTON, S.C. — Science Applications International Corporation of San Diego, Calif. is being awarded a \$6,845,596 Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity, Firm-Fixed-Price, Performance Based type contract to provide 1st Article and Production Frisker Station units in support of NAVSEA. Work will be performed in San Diego and is expected to be completed by September 2005. Contract funds in the amount of \$344,596 will expire at the end of the fiscal year. This contract was not competitively procured, with a posting on the SPAWAR Business Opportunity Web-site and one offer received by closing.
