Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Awards Contract

CHARLESTON, S.C. — M/A-COM Private Radio Systems, Lynchburg, VA, is being awarded a \$10,000,000 Indefinite Quantity, Indefinite Delivery, Firm-Fixed Price type contract (N65236-01-D-5110) for Land Mobile Radio (LMR) Systems to support Wireless Interior Communications Programs for Fleet's trunked LMR Systems. This contract contains one base year and four one-year option periods which is exercised, would bring the cumulative value to this contract to \$47,500,000. Work will be performed at the Contractor's facility in Lynchburg, VA, and is expected to be completed by 27 September 2006. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the fiscal year. This contract will be obligated with the issuance of individual delivery orders. This contract was solicited and negotiated under full and open competition procedures via the SPAWAR E-commerce web site with one offer received.
