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## **Space & Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract**

SAN DIEGO -- Data Link Solutions, a Limited Liability Company, of Cedar Rapids, Iowa is being awarded a \$5,000,000 firm-fixed-price not-to-exceed contract modification to contract N00039-96-C-0038 for the Multifunctional Information Distribution System (MIDS) - Fighter Data Link (FDL) program. The contractor will configure, test, certify, and deliver six MIDS FDL Common Configuration Terminals for the Air Combat Command's F-15 Eagle platform. The Common Configuration Terminal is designed to replace the separate F-15 Eagle (tactical fighter) and F-15E Strike Eagle (air-to-ground tactical attack aircraft) data link terminals with a single, common configuration. The contract will be funded with Air Force Research and Development funds of \$5,000,000. The period of performance is from the effective date of the contract through 31 March 1998. This modification is being awarded on a sole source basis and funding will expire 30 Sept 2000. Approximately 50 percent of the work will be performed in Wayne, New Jersey, and 50 percent of the work will be performed in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command is the contracting agency.
