SAN DIEGO -- Systems Planning and Analysis, Inc. of Alexandria, VA is being awarded a Cost-Plus- Fixed-Fee contract with a base year estimated amount of \$18,315,430 to provide technical and engineering support services to the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Warfare Analysis, Modeling and Simulation Program Office (PMW 131). This office of the Advanced Technology and Prototype Systems Program Directorate (PD 13) supports the Chief of Naval Operations Assessment Division (N81) in executing its assessment and modeling and simulation duties. The contract will provide modeling and simulation services to support the Joint Mission Area/Support Area (JMA/SA) Assessments, the Investment Balance Review (IBR), and Navy participation in the Joint Warfighting Capability Assessment (JWCA) process. The total effort required is expected to be 285,000 staff hours for the base year and for each of four option periods. If exercised, these options will increase the total contract amount to \$96,531,020. This work, which will be performed in Washington D.C., (75 percent) and San Diego (25 percent), should be completed by January 2003. Some contract funds may expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively procured through an electronic solicitation with two offers received. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, San Diego, CA is the contracting activity (N00039-98-C-0101).
