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Space & Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO – ORINCON Corporation of San Diego is being awarded a \$4,133,771 cost-plus-fixed-fee Small Business Innovative Research Phase III contract to analyze and refine Integrated Undersea Surveillance System Automation tasks in support of IUSS Common Architecture for signal processing of undersea sensor data. This contract will provide software upgrades to various architectural components. This contract contains options spread over four years, which if exercised, will bring the total cumulative value to \$35,943,986. Work will be performed in San Diego. The period of performance is from March 26, 1999 through January 31, 2000. The contract is funded with Research and Development funds, and will not expire at the end of the fiscal year. This contract is a follow-on to the SBIR Phase I and II contracts awarded to Orincon. The Phase I contract was competitive under the SBIR guidelines. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command is the contracting activity (N00039-99-C-2213).
