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### **Space & Naval Warfare Systems Center Awards Contract**

SAN DIEGO — Computer Sciences Corporation of San Diego, California is being awarded a \$6,374,216 Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity Cost Reimbursement type contract for research, development, test and evaluation in biological science, chemistry, biochemistry, environmental biotechnology, physics, marine sciences, environmental engineering, advanced sensor development, and radiation physics for ocean surveillance in support of the Navy. A major focus area is marine environmental quality assessment and remediation. This contract contains two option periods, which, if exercised, will bring the total cumulative value of the contract to \$10,945,581. Work will be performed in San Diego. The period of performance is from July 15, 1999 to July 14, 2002. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively procured with 69 firms solicited and one offer received. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center San Diego is the contracting activity (N66001-99-D-5010).
