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Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO — Oracle Corporation of Redwood City, California, is being awarded a \$12,624,320 Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity type contract with a time and material pricing arrangement for research of advanced technologies for human and information system interaction infrastructure. This contract contains one option, which, if exercised, will bring the total cumulative value of the contract to \$15,226,270. There is a minimum guarantee of \$1,294,607. Work will be performed in Herndon, Virginia. The period of performance is from September 20, 1999 to September 19, 2000. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively solicited through the Commerce Business Daily on September 9, 1998 under Broad Agency Announcement N66001-98-X-6905. To date 70 white papers have been received and 23 have been selected for award. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center, San Diego is the contracting activity (N66001-99-D-8517).
