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### **Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract**

SAN DIEGO – Lockheed Martin Corporation, Undersea Systems, of Manassas, VA, is being awarded a \$4,940,521 competitive cost-plus-award-fee contract for services in support of the Integrated Undersea Surveillance Program. This acquisition will provide for civilian technician crews to operate and maintain surveillance mission equipment onboard T-AGOS class ships while on extended at-sea deployments as directed by fleet commanders; provide Field Support Team members for Integrated Undersea Surveillance System (IUSS) engineering and logistic support as well as direct support for Surveillance Towed Array Sensor (SURTASS) ships being prepared for mission; provide Shore Maintenance Team members to maintain mission equipment at U.S. Navy Facilities providing essential support to the global IUSS; provide Shore Analysis Team Members for worldwide acoustic analysis support as directed by IUSS Operational Commanders; provide civilian technicians for operation and maintenance of mission equipment on deployed Japanese Ocean Surveillance ships. This contract contains four one-year options, which if all options are exercised, will bring the cumulative value of the contract to \$31,190,634. The period of performance for the base period is from December 1999 to September 2000. Approximately 75 percent of work for this contract will be performed during extended at-sea deployments. The remaining 25 percent of work will be performed in Manassas, VA (1 percent), Virginia Beach, VA (2 percent), Norfolk, VA (18 percent), Whidby Island, WA (2 percent), and Pearl Harbor, Hawaii (2 percent). This contract will be funded with Operations and Maintenance, Navy (99 percent) and Foreign Military Sales (1 percent) funding. This contract was competitively procured with two offers received. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, San Diego is the contracting activity (N00039-99-0-2206).
