Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Charleston Awards Contract

CHARLESTON, S.C. — BAE Systems Applied Technologies, Rockville, Md. is being awarded an \$8,452,269 indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity, cost-plus-fixed-fee multiple award type contract to provide maintenance and technical services for Automated Tank Gauging, Automated Fuel Handling Equipment and associated systems. This contract involves upgrades of automation components and systems at DoD fuel storage and distribution activities. This contract contains one base year and four one-year options which, if exercised, will bring the total cumulative value of the contract to \$46,443,429. Work will be performed in over 600 worldwide sites in various locations which include CONUS (50%)¹; and OCONUS¹ areas: Pacific (25%), Europe (25%) and is expected to be completed by November 2004. If all options are exercised, work will continue through November 2008. Contract funds in the amount of \$16,666 will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was solicited under full and open competition. The Request for Proposal was posted in the SPAWAR Business Opportunity Web-site with three offers received. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center, Charleston is the contracting activity (N65236-04-D-7851).
