Contracting Information

Total Obligation Authority Claimancy-Wide: \$4.7 Billion – 80% goes directly to contractors
Impact on San Diego: Approximately \$1.2 Billion in monies flows annually into the Greater San Diego Region.

Major Local Contracts:

Systems Engineering & Integration: (SE&I) approx. \$600 million over 5 years (Contract let in 2001)
Program Management Team Omnibus (PMTO) approx. \$400 million over 5 years (Contract let in 1999)

Why SPAWAR Headquarters & Systems Center / PEO C4I & SPACE are located in San Diego:

Close proximity to primary customer (the Fleet located at Naval Station, North Island, Sub base Point Loma). SPAWAR is the only Systems Command so situated.

Able to draw off the High Tech telecommunications and Information Technology Industry locally. SD is a high tech center. SPAWAR is the only Systems Command so located.

Close to major universities and colleges for direct interface with Academia (R&D efforts particularly enhanced by this location).

Joint Services. SPAWAR is close to other military service facilities:

Army: The Army National Training Center, Ft. Irwin,
Marine Corps: MCCA Miramar, Camp Pendleton,
Air Force: Test facility at Edwards AFB,
Other Navy: Naval Air Warfare Center, China Lake, Pt. Mugu

SPAWAR is the only acquisition command so located.
