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SPAWAR Awards Advanced EHF SatCom Terminal Contract

Harris Corporation, Government Communications Systems Division, Melbourne, Fla., is being awarded a \$1,305,000 Other Transaction Agreement for the development of a prototype of a Navy Advanced EHF SATCOM terminal system. This prototype will exhibit the industrial capability to develop, produce, and install a Navy Advanced EHF SATCOM (AEHF) terminal system on ship, shore, and submarine platforms. These terminals will communicate with the AEHF satellite system. This agreement includes options which, if exercised, would bring the cumulative value of this agreement to \$1,770,000. Work will be performed in Palm Bay, Fla., and is expected to be completed by January 2002. Funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This agreement was competitively procured with two offers received via the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Business Opportunities Web Page as advertised in the Commerce Business Daily. This is the first of two awards. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command San Diego is the contracting activity for this agreement (N00039-01-9-4007).
