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Space & Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

Veridian, Veda Operations of Alexandria, VA, is being awarded a \$1,692,050 contract to provide technical and financial support services for Security Assistance/Foreign Military Sales (SA/FMS) to SPAWAR's FMS program office (SPAWAR 054-1). These services will include planning, financial management and executing of Command, Control, Communications, Computers and Intelligence (C4I) FMS programs including pre-case, case execution and general program management support. The support will be provided on a Cost plus Fixed Fee basis for a base and four option years. The total estimated value of the contract, if all options are exercised is \$8,774,635. FMS case and FMS administrative funding sources of \$492,433 will be obligated at award. Veda will work in conjunction with SPAWAR 054-1 to ensure the successful and timely delivery of FMS services to foreign customers. Work will be performed in San Diego and will be completed by 31 January 2004. FMS case funding is non-expiring and FMS administrative funding expires in the fiscal year from which funds are derived. This requirement was released on the World Wide Web on an unrestricted basis, with the only proposal received being from Veridian, Veda Operations. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command is the contracting activity (N00039-99-C-3145).
