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Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Awards Contract

CHARLESTON, S.C. — The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Charleston has awarded three indefinite-delivery, indefinite quantity, cost-plus-fixed-fee contracts for engineering and logistics support of aging weapons systems. Contracts were awarded to: Arinc Inc., of Annapolis, Md., valued at \$13,467,985; Egan McAllister Associates of Lexington Park, Md., valued at \$10,644,806; and Raytheon Technical Services Company of Norfolk, Va., valued at \$10,589,062. Contract requirements include engineering and manufacturing capability to reverse or re-engineer out-of-production weapon systems, subsystems and components of the Army, Air Force, Navy and Marine Corps (such as the CV-22 Osprey aircraft, the KC-135 air refueling tanker and the C-130 Hercules transport aircraft). This multiple award contract from one solicitation includes four one-year options which, if exercised, will bring the total cumulative value of the contracts to \$71,031,686. Work will be performed in Oklahoma City (75%) and Charleston (25%). The period of performance is from December 1999 through December 2000. These contracts will not involve Foreign Military Sales. Contract funds obligated in the amount of \$16,999.97 for each contract are from the Navy Working Capital Fund and will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively procured through the Internet and the SPAWAR Business Opportunities Page, with three offers received. These contracts are funded with Operational and Maintenance Air Force (O&MAF), Operational Procurement Air Force (OPAF) and Operations & Maintenance Navy (O&MN) funds.
