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Space & Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO - Lockheed Martin Tactical Systems of Eagan, Minn., is being awarded a \$27,574,754 indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity contract for system design, development, hardware procurement, test and evaluation, installation and life cycle support to integrate data link functionality and C4ISR capability onto various Taiwan military platforms and sites. The total value, including a base year and six one-year options, is estimated at \$2,151,104,675. This contract involves Foreign Military Sales to Taiwan (100%). Work will be performed in San Diego, Calif. (72.8%); Taiwan (14.6%); Eagan, Minn. (3.3%); various other U.S. locations (9.3%) and is expected to be completed by June 2004. If all options are exercised work will continue through January 2011. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively procured with unlimited proposals solicited and two offers received via the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command E-commerce web site.
