SPAWAR Systems Center San Diego Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO — ASML Inc., of Wilton, Connecticut is being awarded a \$5,193,769 cost-reimbursable, no-fee-type contract for research and development of key areas of an advanced optical parallel-beam, direct-write lithography tool designated as Optical Maskless Lithography. This contract will primarily support the Defense Advanced Research Project Agency's Lithography for Advanced Military Systems Research Program. This is an 18-month contract with no options. All work will be performed at the contractor's site in Wilton, Connecticut. The period of performance is from June 30, 2004 through December 31, 2005. Contract funds obligated in the amount of \$1,163,744 will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was competitively procured via the Federal Business Opportunities website, FedBizOps, under DARPA Broad Agency Announcement number 03-42. Thirty-one offers were received. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center San Diego is the contracting activity (N66001-04-C-8027).
