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Lockheed Martin awarded a \$53,214,581 contract modification

SAN DIEGO — Lockheed Martin Naval Electronics & Surveillance Systems-Undersea Systems, of Manassas, Virginia is being awarded a \$53,214,581 Cost Plus Award Fee contract modification to SPAWAR contract N00039-00-C-2223 for the Engineering and Manufacturing Development (EMD) of the Advanced Deployable System (ADS). The ADS is a quickly deployable undersea surveillance system for littoral waters employing acoustic arrays that produce data that is processed, evaluated, reported and integrated with mission appropriate Naval C4I structure. Raytheon Company, Naval & Maritime Integrated Systems and BBN Technologies are major subcontractors for this effort. This modification brings the total cumulative potential contract value to \$67,681,531. Work will be performed in Manassas VA (36%), Portsmouth R.I. (61%), and Cambridge MA. (3%) and is expected to be completed by December 2005. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This contract was not competitively procured. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command San Diego is the contracting activity (N00039-00-C-2223).
