Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Awards Contract

CHARLESTON, S.C. — Unidyne Corporation, Norfolk, VA, is being awarded a \$9,982,110 modification to previously awarded indefinite-delivery/indefinite-quantity, cost-plus-fixed-fee contract for engineering, technical, installation, manufacturing, and logistics of Navigation Systems and Equipment for all Navy ships. This modification will provide technical services for support of primary and secondary navigation system (AN/WSN-7/7A/7B Ring Laser Gyro Navigator (RLGN)) back-fit installations on various classes of U.S. Navy ships and submarines, including planning and coordination, prefabrication of installation kits, physical installation, optical alignment, and System Operability Verification Test (SOVT). SPAWAR Systems Center Charleston is tasked by the Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) to be the RLGN In-service Engineering Agent (ISEA). As the ISEA, SPAWAR Systems Center Charleston is responsible for insuring the continuous provision of upgrade, installation, maintenance, training, and life cycle support for the entire shipboard navigation system. These services primarily support SPAWAR Systems Center Charleston, Norfolk Navigation Department, Code 343. This contract contains one base year and four one-year option periods. To date, two option periods have been exercised. This contract includes options, which if exercised, would bring the cumulative value of this contract, inclusive of this modification, to \$43,279,298. Work will be performed in Norfolk, VA (45 %); San Diego, CA (29%); Mayport, FL (11 %), and Groton/New London, CT (15%) and is expected to be completed by December 2003. Contract funds will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. This original contract was competitively procured with 51 offerors solicited and three offers received. This modification is being processed in a non-competitive environment and is a sole source action. The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center, Charleston, is the contracting activity.
